Our school has a Bí Cineálta Policy to try stop bullying behaviour. We look at this policy every year to see what is working well or what could work better.

We will ask you what you think!

We want everyone at our school to feel safe and happy. If you think that you are being bullied, or that someone else is being bullied, you need to tell a teacher or another adult that you trust. They will know what to do to help!
